

End User License Agreement

A. LICENSE

Harvard Computing Group, Inc. (also referred to as "HCG", "we" or "us") hereby grants you a license to use the Product (as defined below) in accordance with all of the terms and conditions of this License.

The "Product" consists of: (1) all materials with which this License is packaged by Harvard Computing Group, Inc., which may include, but is not limited to, computer program(s), software, and code; images; photographs; templates; symbols; texts; accompanying printed materials; and "online" or electronic documentation, and (2) any supplemental software code and supporting materials which may be provided to you as part of support services provided or authorized by Harvard Computing Group, Inc. for the Product, and (3) the TaskMap® method incorporated in training and software materials herein.

B. YOU MAY:

1. Install and use one copy of the Product on a single computer for use by a single individual. For the avoidance of doubt, a single user license, also known as a standalone or node-locked license, is limited to use by a single individual on a single computer; sharing of node-locked licenses between individuals sharing a computer is not allowed. A license is required for each individual user of the Product., or
2. [If you purchased a workgroup multi-seat license]: install the Product on more than one computer. For example, if your purchase receipt specifies a workgroup multi-seat license for 100 computers, the Product may be installed on up to 100 individual PCs.
3. [If you purchased a concurrent multi-seat license]: install the Product on all computers you wish to license in the organization for use by **multiple individuals** subject to the limits of concurrent licenses purchased (i.e. numbers of licenses purchased and any site licensing agreement in force).
4. Make one copy of the Product for archive or backup purposes.
